In readings regarding advice in a relationship, The Magician is very positive. They could tell you that you need to develop your communication skills with your partner(s) to ensure ultimate success. Or, this could be shaping an ideal partner.

**Reversed: *Arrogance, Weakness, Missed Opportunities, Powerlessness***

When the Magician card is in reverse, it indicates the possibility of untapped power, manipulation, and dishonesty. This implies that the individual may have the means to reach their objectives but needs to be using them effectively. This may be caused by a lack of self-confidence, focus, or an incomplete understanding of their capabilities.

Furthermore, the reversed Magician warns of potential deceit and deception, whether by the querent or someone close to them. It suggests that not everything is as it seems, emphasizing the importance of being able to differentiate between the truth and falsehood. The card advises caution against using one's abilities for manipulative purposes or becoming the victim of someone else's manipulation. Thus, it urges the individual to reevaluate their motives and intentions, and gain a deeper understanding of their true potential.

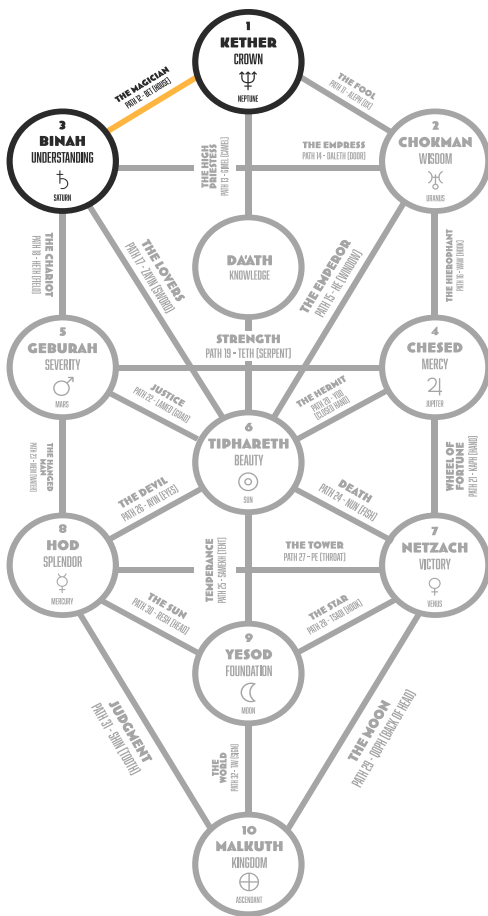

The four symbols on the table represent the four suits. The Magician can transmute intangible creativity and concepts into tangible results with each. One arm is stretched toward the heavens while the other points toward the Earth, signifying their role as a conduit between the divine realms and the physical world. This pose also references the magickal phrase, “As above, so below,” meaning mind and matter are reflections of one another.

The Magician is all about manifestation, resourcefulness, and power. They signify the ability to harness and use the universe’s energy to create and influence the physical world. This card indicates that you have the tools, resources, and knowledge to meet your goals and achieve your desires. When the Magician appears in a reading, it often suggests that it’s an excellent time to begin a new project or start a new phase in your life, as the energies are suitable for manifestation.

At a deeper level, the Magician emphasizes the power of transformation and reminds us of their innate ability to shape their destiny. Drawing this card can mean a period where one’s potential can be fully realized with focus, will, and intent. It serves as a reminder that you have the magic to create your desired life.



**ZODIAC:** Gemini (May 21 – June 20) is an Air sign ruled by Mercury. Geminis often feel as though they have two distinct sides to their personalities. Virgo (August 23rd – September 22nd) is an Earth sign ruled by Mercury. Virgos are selfless and dedicated, often putting others’ needs above their own.



**PLANET:** Mercury is the smallest planet in our solar system and the closest to the Sun. Mercury, the messenger of the gods, represents communication and reasoning.



**ELEMENT:** Air represents logic, intellect, and communication. The intangible element is considered to be active, masculine energy. It is associated with Spring, the Suit of Wands, and the East cardinal direction.
