



The High Priestess is typically depicted seated between two pillars, one black and one white, symbolizing duality. These pillars often carry the letters B and J, representing the pillars of Solomon's temple — Boaz and Jachin. The High Priestess embodies intuition, unconscious knowledge, and mysteries. When they appear in a reading, they often suggest that you rely more on your intuition and inner wisdom than on conscious, logical thinking. This card may also indicate that hidden influences are at play and that not everything is as it seems.

The High Priestess represents a deep understanding of the universe, a bridge between the seen and the unseen. They encourage introspection and self-reflection, urging one to look beyond the obvious and tap into the deeper realms of their psyche and the universe.

Drawing this card can also mean a time of waiting and patience. The answers one seeks might not be immediately apparent, and it's essential to trust the process, letting things unfold naturally. The High Priestess is a reminder of each individual's vast, untapped potential and wisdom, accessible through intuition, dreams, and meditation.



ZODIAC: Cancer (June 21 – July 22) is a Water sign ruled by the Moon. Cancers are highly empathetic, although they can be initially perceived as cold and distant. They're often caregivers and nurturing.



PLANET: The Moon is the ruler of Cancer and represents one's deepest emotional needs. It is associated with the mother and feminine energy. It rules rhythmic ebb and flow of activity and energy.



ELEMENT: Water rules emotions and is a symbol of healing, peace, dreams, and compassion. It is associated with Winter, the Suit of Cups, and the West cardinal direction.
