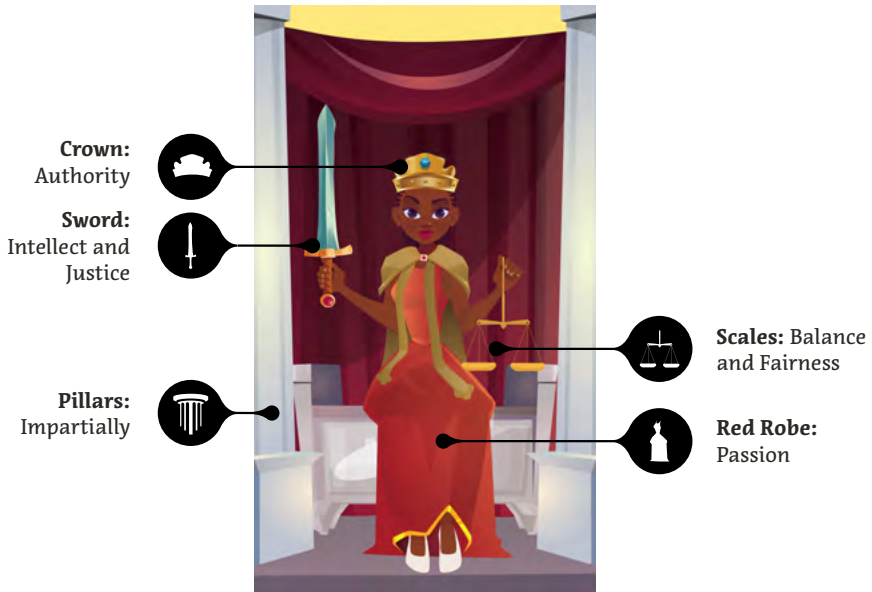

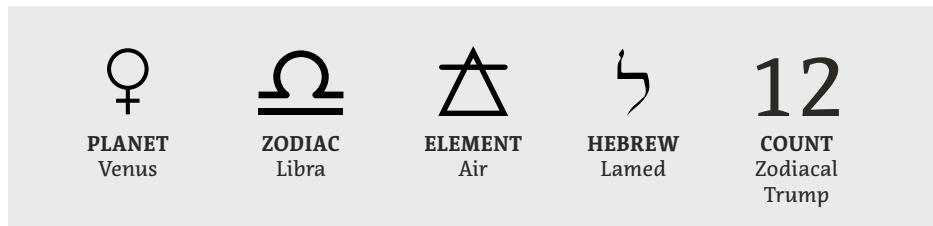

**Upright: Integrity, Truth, Fairness, Balance, Accountability, Law, Reality**

When the Justice card appears in a Tarot reading, it represents principles of honesty, balance, and the consequences of one's actions. The card suggests that decisions must be made with a thorough understanding of their repercussions and that actions have outcomes.

The Justice card often indicates that a legal dispute will end in the querent's favor or that a significant decision must be made after weighing all potential consequences. It encourages integrity and treating others with fairness. On a personal level, the Justice card implies that one is considering all aspects of a situation and emphasizes using both intuition and logic to guide decisions.

Above all, the card emphasizes the principle of fairness and the law of karma: one's actions will eventually have consequences.

**Reversed: Lack of Responsibility, Dishonesty, Corruption, Retaliation, Bias, Lies**

If the Justice card appears in reverse during a reading, it could indicate that an unjust decision, prejudice, or bias is affecting you or someone close to you.

Additionally, it could suggest that either you or someone else is attempting to evade responsibility or avoid facing the consequences of their actions. Should you find yourself involved in a legal matter, the reversed Justice card could indicate delays, setbacks, or an unfavorable verdict.

It is important to consider any internal or external imbalances that may be influencing your decision-making, as this card may signify that you are relying too heavily on emotion rather than logic. Reflect on whether your actions and decisions align with your values and if you are being truthful with yourself and others.

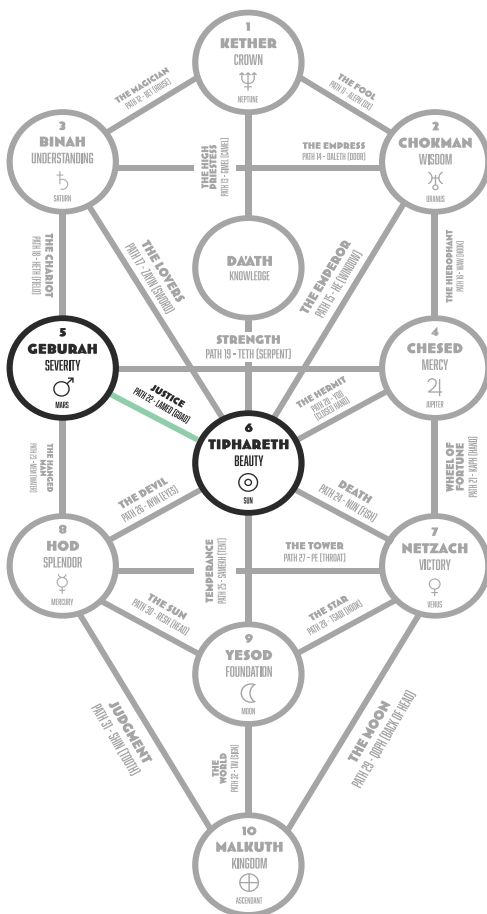

The Justice card showcases a dignified figure, typically depicted as an individual, sitting gracefully on a throne. They represent the ideals of truth and impartiality, holding perfectly balanced scales in one hand to symbolize fairness and the importance of equilibrium in judgment. Their other hand clutches a double-edged sword pointing upwards, a representation of objective decision-making and an acknowledgment of the dual outcomes that can arise from any ruling.

This embodiment of Justice often adorns a crown adorned with a distinctive square, signifying the clarity and rationality required in rendering fair judgments. Clad in flowing robes of deep red or royal purple, they exude an unwavering passion for truth and command a regal presence.

The background features two grey pillars, reminiscent of those on the High Priestess card, which highlight the interplay between intuition and logic that is necessary for harmony and balance.



**ZODIAC:** Libra (September 23 – October 22) is an Air sign ruled by Venus. Libras often strive for harmony and balance in their lives.



**PLANET:** Venus primarily governs love, harmony, and affection in relationships. It rules over our sentiments, what we value in romantic partnerships, and how we express affection.



**ELEMENT:** Air represents logic, intellect, and communication. The intangible element is considered to be active, masculine energy. It is associated with Spring, the Suit of Wands, and the East cardinal direction.
