Upright: Friendship, Community, Gatherings, Support, Happiness, Celebration

The Three of Cups stands tall and radiates a message of communal joy, celebration, and unity. It symbolizes an upcoming period where social connections, shared laughter, and the essence of togetherness are paramount.

This card often appears in readings that suggest upcoming celebrations, gatherings, or reunions. It could be a joyous occasion like a wedding, birth announcement, or a simple get-together with loved ones. It represents deeper emotional bonds in relationships, such as harmonious connections and close friendships. These connections rejuvenate our spirits and remind us of the happiness of shared memories and mutual appreciation.

The Three of Cups symbolizes collaboration and teamwork, especially in creative endeavors. It may signify successful projects or merging talents to create something beautiful and significant. It represents that coming together as a collective often enhances our abilities and results in more magnificent outcomes than we might achieve alone.

Reversed: Overindulgence, Loneliness, Termination, Isolation, Gossip, An Affair

The Three of Cups in reverse suggests disharmony, miscommunication, and potential conflicts within a group. Fractures may arise due to either external circumstances or internal dynamics. Celebrations may be delayed, relationships may experience misunderstandings, or a once harmonious group could face internal strife or competition. It may also indicate feelings of isolation or isolation from one's social circle. It can allude to times when one feels left out or when celebrations seem insincere.

It may highlight the dangers of excessive indulgence, warning against excessive partying or neglecting responsibilities for short-lived pleasures. This card serves as a reminder to balance social interactions, communicate effectively, and approach situations with understanding and empathy.

Upright Interpretations

General Reading: The Three of Cups embodies celebration, community, and collective joy. It speaks to the beauty of shared experiences, coming together with others, and reveling in the moment. This card can represent a gathering, party, or any event where camaraderie and happiness abound.

Love Reading: In terms of romance, the Three of Cups suggests a joyful time – this could be an engagement, a wedding, or just a time of happiness and bonding in a relationship. For singles, it might indicate that they'll meet potential partners in social settings or through mutual friends.

Health Reading: For health, the Three of Cups is a favorable sign, hinting at rejuvenation and recovery. It could also indicate a time of relaxation, taking breaks with friends, or perhaps attending therapeutic group sessions.

Career Reading: In the professional realm, this card can signify a team's success, a project's completion, or just a time for the team to celebrate and bond. It emphasizes collaboration and shared achievements.

Reversed Interpretations

General Reading: The reversed Three of Cups might signify celebrations gone awry, conflicts in social circles, or overindulgence. It can hint at the need to curb excesses or to reconsider the company one keeps.

Love Reading: In romance, this card reversed can indicate a third-party situation, or complications arising from external influences. It might also suggest temporary separations or conflicts in a relationship.

Health Reading: From a health perspective, overindulgence, particularly in terms of substances, might be a concern. It encourages one to maintain moderation and be wary of peer pressure.

Career Reading: In work and career situations, the reversed Three of Cups could indicate team disagreements, unsuccessful projects, or missed opportunities to celebrate due to setbacks.

The Three of Cups commemorates moments when we unite with our loved ones, family, or community to revel in mutual joy, be it an accomplishment, marking milestones, or simply basking in the company of one another.

At the card's core, we see three figures, often women, depicted dancing in a circle or raising their cups to toast. Their happy expressions and harmonious dance or gestures convey mutual respect, friendship, and a profound sense of belonging. The figures are often dressed in flowing dresses or robes, capturing a sense of freedom, movement, and unbridled happiness. Their attire underpins the card's festive essence and emotions' fluidity. Each figure holds a cup, raised high in jubilation, representing emotional contentment and the delight of shared experiences. Raising these cups is an indication of giving and sharing positive emotions.

The card's setting typically boasts an abundance of flowers or fruits, either on the ground or in the surrounding area, symbolizing the tangible rewards of life and the physical representation of abundance and prosperity. The background of the card, frequently a clear sky or a lush landscape, amplifies the positive and unrestricted moment, suggesting a time unburdened by limitations.



ZODIAC: Pisces (February 19 – March 20) is a Water sign ruled by Neptune. Pisceans are known for their emotional depth and keen intuition.



Scorpio (October 23 – November 21) is a Water sign ruled by Pluto. Scorpions are known for their intensity and depth.



Cancer (June 21 – July 22) is a Water sign ruled by the Moon. Cancers are highly empathetic, although they can be initially perceived as cold and distant. They're often caregivers and nurturing.



ELEMENT: Water rules emotions and is a symbol of healing, peace, dreams, and compassion. It is associated with Winter, the Suit of Cups, and the West cardinal direction.
