**Upright: *Loving, Intuitive, Empath, Beauty, Psychic, Calm, Spiritual, Faithful***

This person leads with their heart, offering a listening ear and a shoulder to cry on. Their insights are not solely cerebral but arise from a profound understanding and empathy.

The Queen of Cups prompts introspection and the exploration of intuition, dreams, and unconscious feelings. It emphasizes the importance of emotional responses that stem from understanding and wisdom rather than mere reactions. This encourages the nurturing of psychic abilities and the development of an innate sense of knowing that often defies logical explanation. Like water flows and ripples, the Queen of Cups suggests that creative energy is overflowing and waiting to be harnessed and shared with the world through writing, music, art, or any other form of expression.

**Reversed: *Self-Care, Sensitive, Shallow, Martyrdom, Insecurity, Dependence***

The reversed Queen of Cups may point to an individual who relies heavily on others for emotional support or smothers those around them with excessive care and attention. This behavior can become overbearing and even manipulative, using emotional sensitivity as a weapon to play the victim or guilt others into getting their way. The genuine compassion and empathy typically associated with this card may be replaced by emotional insecurity and neediness.

Furthermore, the appearance of this card may suggest a disconnect from intuition and inner knowing, prompting the individual to reconnect with their intuitive self and trust their gut feelings. Just because something cannot be logically explained does not mean it is invalid. Taking time for self-reflection and meditation can help ground and regain the emotional and intuitive balance the Queen of Cups represents in its upright position. It is a reminder to prioritize emotional well-being and to find healthy ways to express and manage one's feelings.

## Upright Interpretations

This vessel, frequently sealed or capped, symbolizes the profound depths of their emotions and subconscious. The waters around them and the cup in their possession signify their deep bond with the emotional realm and their intuitive gifts.

Seashells commonly adorn their throne, underscoring their reign over the domain of feelings and their connection to the unconscious mind's unfathomable depths. The calm sea and cloudless sky behind them convey tranquility, indicating their control over their emotions, utilizing them as a source of strength rather than becoming overwhelmed.

Their serene and compassionate demeanor is apparent as they intently gaze at their cup, signifying their awareness and respect for their internal world and others' emotional needs. Their presence in a reading often points to characteristics such as empathy, intuition, emotional depth, and a sympathetic nature.



**ZODIAC:** Pisces (February 19 – March 20) is a Water sign ruled by Neptune. Pisceans are known for their emotional depth and keen intuition.



Scorpio (October 23 – November 21) is a Water sign ruled by Pluto. Scorpions are known for their intensity and depth.



Cancer (June 21 – July 22) is a Water sign ruled by the Moon. Cancers are highly empathetic, although they can be initially perceived as cold and distant. They're often caregivers and nurturing.
