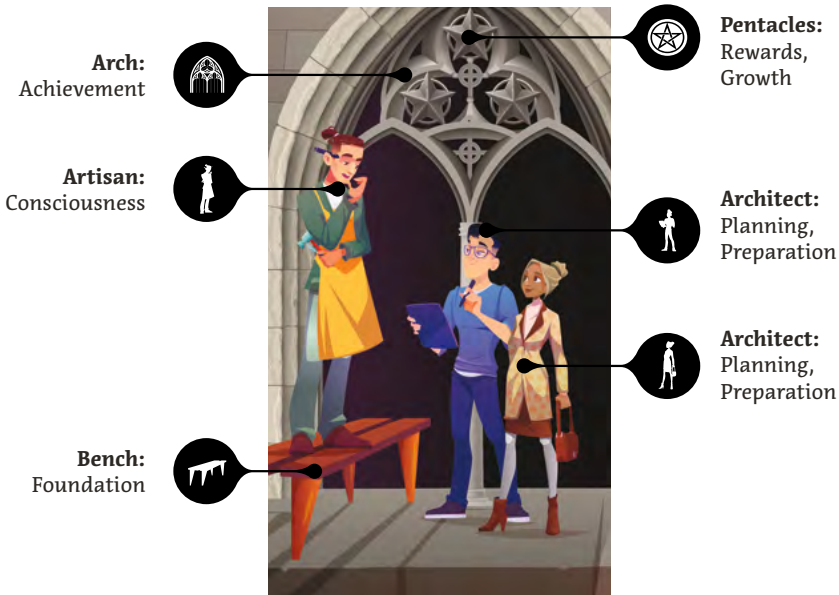



**Upright: Teamwork, Improving Skills, Implementation, Learning, Collaboration**

Thus, the Three Pentacles speaks of collective effort and skill and the importance of laying solid and precise foundations for future success.

**Reversed: Disharmony, Ego, Disorganization, Group Conflict, Working Alone**

One of the central themes of the reversed Three of Pentacles is a lack of teamwork or collaboration. The reversed card might also hint at needing more expertise or preparation. Perhaps there’s a rush to complete a project without paying attention to the details, or there might be a need for more planning and foresight. The craftsmanship and skill associated with the upright card may need to be utilized, leading to subpar results. It’s a warning to ensure that the right skills are being applied to tasks and to pay heed to the foundational stages of any endeavor for long-term success.

## Upright Interpretations

**Career Reading:** This is a time where your skills are recognized, and you're encouraged to work in tandem with others. Projects undertaken now have a strong foundation. It also could indicate mentoring opportunities or learning phases that will contribute positively to your career growth.

## Reversed Interpretations

**Career Reading:** When reversed in a career context, the Three of Pentacles might suggest conflicts at work or projects that are stalling due to a lack of collaboration. It can also indicate feeling undervalued or overlooked in your professional contributions. The card advises reassessing team dynamics and ensuring clear communication to overcome challenges.

At the forefront of the card, an eye-catching triad of pentacles, which signify the fruits of one's labor and the rewards of their efforts. The central figure, often depicted as a skilled artisan or craftsman. This representation embodies the unwavering commitment and focus necessary to produce quality work that is valued by all. The tools held by the craftsman symbolize the practical aspect of the work, highlighting the skills in action and the means through which ideas come to life.

Working alongside the artisan are typically one or two additional figures, shown holding blueprints or architectural plans. These figures emphasize the importance of planning, collaboration, and foresight, highlighting that exceptional work requires practical skills and visionary planning.

The structure on which the craftsman stands or works is an emblem of progress and the creation process, representing the foundation of the project and its early stages. Meanwhile, the background showcases the beginnings of a grand structure, often a cathedral or other spiritual edifice, underscoring the themes of construction, progress, and collective achievement.



**ZODIAC:** Taurus (April 20 – May 20) is an Earth sign ruled by Venus. This sign embodies those that are grounded, practical, and stable.
