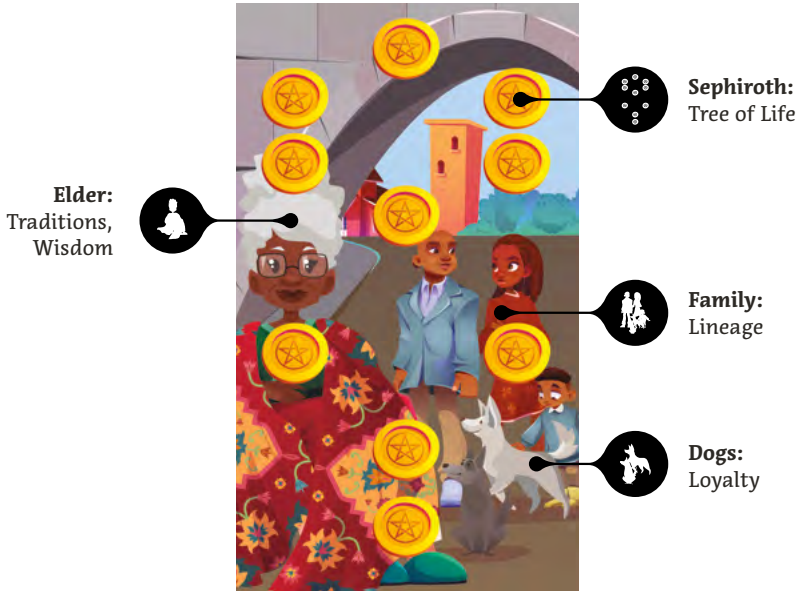

The Ten of Pentacles features a multi-generational family, highlighting the importance of lineage, inheritance, and family traditions. The ten pentacles are arranged in the shape of the sephiroth, symbolizing stability, wealth, and material success and framing the family to represent protection and the complete integration of material success into their lives.

An arch or gateway is often depicted, indicating protection, prosperity, or entering a new phase of life that promises security and abundance. The presence of an older person close by but separate from the family signifies wisdom, the passage of time, and leaving a legacy. Dogs are present, symbolizing loyalty, trust, and protection and creating an environment of comfort and security.

The background might feature a grand home or castle, emphasizing wealth, stability, and the idea of assets or property being passed down. Vines and grapes may also represent growth, fertility, and abundance and suggest that wealth has grown over time or through the generations.



ZODIAC: Taurus (April 20 – May 20) is an Earth sign ruled by Venus. This sign embodies those that are grounded, practical, and stable.



Virgo (August 23 – September 22) is an Earth sign ruled by Mercury. Virgos are selfless and dedicated, often putting others' needs above their own.
