The background usually features a field with freshly tilled soil or crops ready for harvest, conveying the notions of hard work, patience, and the rewards of dedication. The Knight frequently holds a shield with the pentacle emblem, indicating their association with the material world, practical endeavors, and commitment to tangible outcomes.

The Knight's armor symbolizes their preparedness and protection. They are poised to face challenges in a strategic and calculated manner, rather than with impulsive bravery. The earthy tones dominating the card ground it in the realm of the tangible and material. These colors emphasize the Knight's connection to the Earth element and their pragmatic approach to life.
