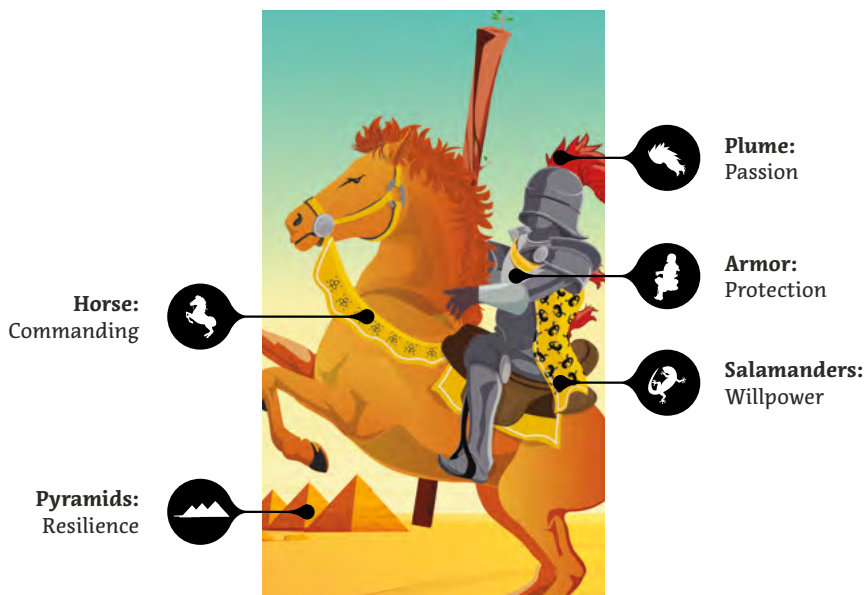

Often, their attire is adorned with salamanders, creatures associated with fire, and a plume of feathers on their helmet. The salamanders, particularly when shown eating their tails in a nod to the Ouroboros, symbolize cyclical transformation, endurance, and the continual renewal of energy.

The backdrop of a desert or barren land serves as a reminder of the Knight's occasional recklessness and tendency to act without considering the consequences. Fueled by passion and confidence, they may overlook details or rush into situations without fully understanding them. The desert scenery may hint at the potential outcomes of such haste, suggesting that while the Knight possesses the enthusiasm to start ventures, they may not always see them through to fertile completion.
