GOOD HEALTH, RENEWAL, FAITH, SPIRITUALITY, INSPIRATION, HOPE

The Star usually depicts a nude feminine figure kneeling in front of a pond, pouring from a jug into the body of water. In the sky is a large, golden star surrounded by seven smaller stars. This card represents the rewards reaped by those who show generosity.


